California State Senate's **Tenth Biennial** California **Contemporary Art Collection** 2017-18 **Art Exhibit**

Senator Jeff Stone is currently accepting entries from artists residing in the 28th Senate District who are interested in having their original art displayed at the upcoming California Contemporary Art Collection 2017-2018 Art Exhibit at the State Capitol. Only one artist and art piece will be selected to represent the 28th Senate District on exhibit and in the exhibit catalogue.

Note: The artist must agree to loan their art to the exhibit for approximately 18 months. The exhibit schedule is planned from May 2017 - October 2018. The artist's biography and artwork will be included in the exhibit catalogue. Senator Stone's office will work with the selected artist in making sure the art is received in the State Capitol no later than Thursday, April 28, 2017.

What you need:

- Completed entry form.
- A picture (no larger than 8" x 10") of the artwork to be considered. Most any type of ORIGINAL art is acceptable.

Oil paintings, works on paper, weavings, wall hangings, and sculpture are all acceptable media. Note: Please try to limit the overall size to no larger than 3' x 5'.

No posters or prints – only original pieces.
